
Bourd Track Racer



The 2019 growing season was unique. Overall, temperatures across the growing season were slightly above 20-year averages. A minor frost event at the end of September was followed by a series of larger, statewide frosts and freezes in early to mid-October. Despite these challenges, growers and winemakers alike were excited about the quality of fruit they picked 2019. Cooler temperatures contributed to lower overall sugar accumulation and higher acidities, which many welcomed.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Board Track Racer Cabernet Sauvignon checks in at 77% Cabernet Sauvignon with a blend of Merlot, Malbec, and a splash of Petit Verdot. Dark, dense flavors including blackberry and blueberry compote present on the nose and carry onto the palate. Integrated oak characteristics develop mid-palate with cocoa and vanilla, and mingle with cherry and more dark fruits that lead into a lengthy finish.
