WINEMAKING NOTES

Black Love is a selection of our favorite Pinot Noir barrels sourced from top Willamette Valley vineyards. A blend of three premium clones -Pommard, Clone 115, and Clone 777 - creates a balance of lush dark fruits, earthy aromatics, and age-worthy structure in the wine. The 2021 growing season throughout the region is considered exceptional, with balanced yields and high-quality fruit. The season started a bit earlier than average, with bloom occurring in the first week of June under optimal weather conditions. The season progressed with an unusual heat dome at the end of June, which thankfully did not affect the vineyards at that stage in development. The second half of the season was warmer than average, with dry conditions until a few isolated rain events and cooling in early September that helped build complex flavors. Grapes were harvested between September 15th and October 4th in beautiful weather, resulting in exceptional fruit with beautifully balanced flavors and silky textures in the wine.

TASTING NOTES

A rich, full-bodied expression of Willamette Valley Pinot Noir made for the Mark Ryan fan. On the nose, aromas of graphite, tea, and dark plum are joined by flavors of ripe black and blue fruits and cacao. Integrated tannins lead to a long fruit-filled finish.
