Winemaking Notes

The 2015 Old Vines Cabernet Sauvignon honors some of the oldest and most well-respected vineyards in the state. At the core, Ciel du Cheval and Klipsun offer powerful Red Mountain character. Red Willow brings the savory, old-world charm of the Yakima Valley. Phinny Hill rounds out the wine, displaying the force and energy of the Horse Heaven Hills. Old Vines tend to be more self-regulating in the vineyard, offering lighter crops, smaller berries and extremely concentrated aromatics and flavors. Our job in the cellar is to carefully extract these qualities without going too far and creating a wine that is unapproachable and hard. Great care is taken in the cellar to gently handle the must, which is never pumped and is punched down twice a day to create gentle extraction. Once fermentation is complete the wine is lightly pressed to barrel where it will age for 21 months in 78% new French oak.

Tasting Notes (92-94) Points

"The 2015 Old Vines is a tiny, 235-case production based on Cabernet Sauvignon. Seeing just under 80% new French oak, it has a very pretty, perfumed, fresh style in its violets, blueberry, mint and bay leaf aromas and flavors. Medium to full-bodied, nicely concentrated and with good acidity, it has a firm, focused style and I wouldn't open bottles for at least 3-5 years."
